## ANNEXURE – A

Sr No	Description/Compliances	Agree/Disagree
1	Vehicles used for transportation shall be in accordance with the provision under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and rules made there under.	
2	Transporter should have valid "Pollution Under Control Certificate" PUCC during the transportation of the treated industrial waste water and shall be properly displayed.	
3	Vehicles shall be painted preferably in blue color with white strip of 15 to 60 cm width running centrally all over the body. This is to facilitate easy identification.	
4	Vehicles should be fitted with mechanical handling equipments as may be required for safe handling and transportation of the wastes.	
5	The word "Treated industrial waste water" shall be displayed on all sides of the vehicles in Vernacular Language, Hindi and English.	
6	Vehicles shall be fitted with roll-on/roll-off covers if the individual containers do not possess the same.	
7	Carrying of passengers is strictly prohibited and those associated with the waste haulers, shall be permitted only in the cabin.	
8	Transporter shall carry documents of manifest for the treated industrial waste water during transportation as procedure mentioned in Rules-21 of the Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transportation Movement) Rules, 2008.	
9	The truck shall be dedicated for the transportation for treated industrial waste water and they shall not be used for any other purpose.	
10	Each vehicle shall carry first aid kit, spill control equipment and fire extinguisher.

11	Treated industrial waste water transport vehicle shall run only at a speed specified under Motor & Vehicle Act in order to avoid any eventuality during the transportation of Treated Industrial waste water	
12	Transport of Treated industrial waste water shall be in accordance with the provisions of the rules made by the Central Government under the Motor & Vehicle Act, 1988 and other guidelines issued from time to time in this regard.	
13	Educational qualification for the driver shall be Minimum of 10 <sup>th</sup> pass (SSC). The driver of the transport vehicles shall have valid driving license for heavy vehicles from State Road Transport Authority and shall have experience transporting of chemicals.	
14	Driver (s) shall be properly trained for the handling of emergency situation and safety aspects involved in the transportation of hazardous waste.	
15	The design of the truck shall be such that there is no spillage during transportation.	
16	The receptors of treated waste water shall ensure the compliance of the conditions stipulated in the consents issued under the Air Act-1981 and Water Act-1974 and Environment Protection Act-1986.	
17	Transportation of treated waste water for disposal purpose shall be carried out only through dedicated tankers with <b>GPS</b> enabled system in line with Hazardous Waste Rules-2008.	
18	The compiled data shall be submitted by them to the concerned Regional offices of GPCB for verification at the end of every month.
